Victim of Violence Secures Safety for Herself and Her Children

When “Pam” entered the Legal Aid Society offices, she was mentally and physically hurt. The abuse was visible with swollen lips and bruises on her face from the most recent incident. Afraid, frustrated, hopeless, and seeking protection from her husband, Pam was currently living in a domestic violence shelter. She couldn’t understand how the person who had once promised to take care of her was capable of now physically and sexually abusing her. Pam wanted to leave her situation, but she felt guilty leaving her husband and the father of their children. However, Pam’s husband had also become more abusive with the children. He would forcibly have sex with Pam, threatening to hit the children if she would not have sex with him or if she screamed. On the most recent occasion, her husband sexually and physically assaulted her. As she tried to fight him off, he got angrier and angrier, grabbing her hair and continually hitting her harder and harder in the mouth and on the face. Eventually, to stop the hitting and to keep the children safe, Pam gave up the physical fight and stayed quiet. When the abuser went to the bathroom, she managed to grab her children and the car keys to escape. Pam knew she had to stop the abuse for the sake of the children.

Legal Aid Society helped Pam obtain an ex parte protective order the day she came in and successfully represented her at the hearing to obtain a permanent protective order against her husband. In a recent conversation with Pam, she said, “I am living my dream—a life without violence, a life without the uncertainty of what will happen next.”

Letter From the Campaign Chair

It is only because of you—because of your generosity, because of your commitment to the ideal of justice for all—that “AND JUSTICE FOR ALL” has been able to increase access to justice for disadvantaged Utahns. Your investment in these vital services has truly made a difference.

Last year, the “AND JUSTICE FOR ALL”-supported programs assisted over 40,000 individuals with their civil legal problems. Approximately 170 individuals come for legal help every day, simply trying to address the problems that arise out of everyday life. A typical day would bring 33 victims of domestic violence seeking protection, 64 individuals with other family law matters, 34 seniors with elder law issues, 18 individuals with disabilities trying to address legal issues related to their disabilities, 15 households with housing problems and 8 individuals seeking public benefits.

Because of your support, all of these individuals received some level of assistance with their legal problems. Limited resources require that we assist many clients at clinics, with advice over the phone and “unbundled” services, so that we can continue to provide full representation in the cases with the greatest impact.

This is my final year as the Chair of the “AND JUSTICE FOR ALL” Campaign. It has been a great pleasure working with my colleagues in the legal community and individuals and corporation from outside the legal community who understand that access to legal help is the only way our society can thrive. Thank you for your generosity. Thank you for inspiring me. Thank you for making a difference for those who would otherwise not have access to legal help.

Man Keeps Job & Obtains Back Pay

“Jason” is a 34 year old man who is deaf. He had been successfully working as a plumber for 16 years with limited hearing capacity, but awoke one morning to find he had gone completely deaf. The client called his employer to inform them of his condition and that he had to go to the doctor. The employer responded by saying they would not accommodate his deafness and that he could not return to work until his hearing was restored.

Jason immediately contacted the Disability Law Center for help. We met with the client to

review his complaint and drafted a formal reasonable accommodation request to his employer. The company never responded. During that same time, the client had submitted a complaint to the Utah Anti-Discrimination and Labor Division. The employer agreed to meet with the client for mediation. During the mediation, the Disability Law Center argued that the company effectively denied his request for accommodation by not responding to our letter. Further, we argued that it was unlawful to not allow our client to return to work.

The company agreed. Jason received \$13,900 in back wages and was able to return to work within a month to allow the company time to find assistive technology that would enable our client to perform his job safely. The company further agreed to fully accommodate Jason’s needs at work, as well as to reinstate the client at his previous set schedule – a preferred schedule he had earned during his time with the company.

Jason is thrilled to be back at work so he can support himself financially and be a productive member of our society.

Protecting Seniors From Consumer Abuse

“Martha” is in her 80’s and her only source of income is social security. She went to the dentist’s office based on an ad offering several free services, including a dental exam. The ad indicated that any services would be interest-free for a year. As is the case with most seniors, her only medical insurance is Medicare which does not cover routine dental care or most dental procedures such as cleanings, fillings, tooth extractions or dentures. The ad sounded like a good deal and she made an appointment.

The dentist proposed a comprehensive treatment plan that would cost several thousand dollars. He encouraged Martha to sign up for a credit card so she could put her dental charges on the credit card with the assurance all services would be free of interest and finance charges for a period of twelve months. She signed up for the credit

card, the dentist did some initial work that cost a few hundred dollars but submitted a bill to the credit card company for the entire treatment plan although the services had not yet been provided.

The credit card company immediately charged the several thousand dollars to her credit card account and began applying finance charges. She met with the dentist a few more times and had some additional work done. However, the credit card company had still been billed for several thousand dollars of work that had not been done and never would be done. She contacted the dentist’s office and the credit card company multiple times to resolve this problem, but was unsuccessful.

She came to Utah Legal Services with her meticulous records and ULS contacted the

dentist and the credit card company. Within a month, the dentist refunded most of the overcharged amount to the credit card company. It took another few months to get the matter completely resolved. In the end, the credit card company removed all interest and late charges and the dentist reimbursed Martha for the overpayments she had made to the credit card company.
