Woman Finds Safety, Independence & Security for Herself and Her Children

Jane turned to Utah Legal Services for help to get a divorce from her abusive alcoholic husband John. He frequently harassed Jane and their children. Because of the alcoholism, John was a nightmare to live with. He was both physically and emotionally abusive to Jane anytime he was drunk,

which sadly was more often than not. The case came to Utah Legal Services after it was already initiated. Jane was dropped by her attorney because she couldn't pay his fees. We were able to finally get the case to mediation and come to an agreement regarding all remaining issues,

including a provision forcing John to seek and undergo treatment before being awarded regular, unsupervised parent-time with his children. The divorce is now final and Jane is free to move on with her life. She is excited about what the future has to offer her and her children.

Father Fights for the Right to Raise his Children

In October 2013, Alex filed yet another custody action for his two children he had been raising alone for the past ten years. Alex's two previous attempts to obtain child support and financial assistance from the children's mother had both been dismissed for failing to file the required paperwork. This time, Alex again struggled through the complicated process without help from an attorney for

almost two years. During these two years Alex was brought into court and chastised for not moving the case forward at three different hearings, although Alex was never given an explanation on

how to move the case forward. Then in the summer of 2015, Alex was accepted as a client by the Legal Aid Society of Salt Lake City. By Thanksgiving Day, Legal Aid was able to help

Alex through two hearings and ultimately negotiate a full settlement of Alex's case including an award of over \$9,000.00 in unpaid child support for John's two children.

Medicaid Decision Overturned; Lives Saved

Twenty-nine year old Valerie and her thirty-one year old brother Dennis (Den) live in rural ranch country near Myton, Utah. The whole family participates in their physical and emotional care. They are never left alone. During the day, they lie in the home's bright comfortable living room engaged in family life. At night, Carol, their mother, sleeps in a recliner next to Valerie. Den's father shares a room with him. Three siblings pitch in as well, delighting in the way Den teases and sharing in his passion for cars. They also support Valerie's love for babies, jewelry,

"anything with four legs" and having pretty hair and fingernails. In the past, Valerie and Den's disabilities caused them to aspirate when eating; ten years ago, Valerie began using a feeding tube, Den got one four years later. Until this year, Medicaid has been covering the cost of their liquid food, their only source of nutrition. When Den's annual re-authorization of services came around, Medicaid declined to pay for the food. The agency stated that there was no medical



need for it and suggested that the family pay for the food with food stamps. When Valerie's review came around a few months later, Medicaid issued the same decision. The cost of one month's food for the brother and sister is \$700. The decision had a financial

implications that would be detrimental to the family's well-being. Soon after this decision the family called the Disability Law Center (DLC) for some much-needed help. "Nate was awesome" reports Carol of her experience with the DLC attorney. "Medicaid gave us the run-around and he waded through 300 pages of medical records to find the three that would help our case.... He went above and beyond, even accompanying us to an appointment with the nutritionist in order to gather information to prove the liquid food is specialized and serves a medical purpose." Nate represented the family through the appeal process. The result, Medicaid reversed their decision and began paying for the food again.

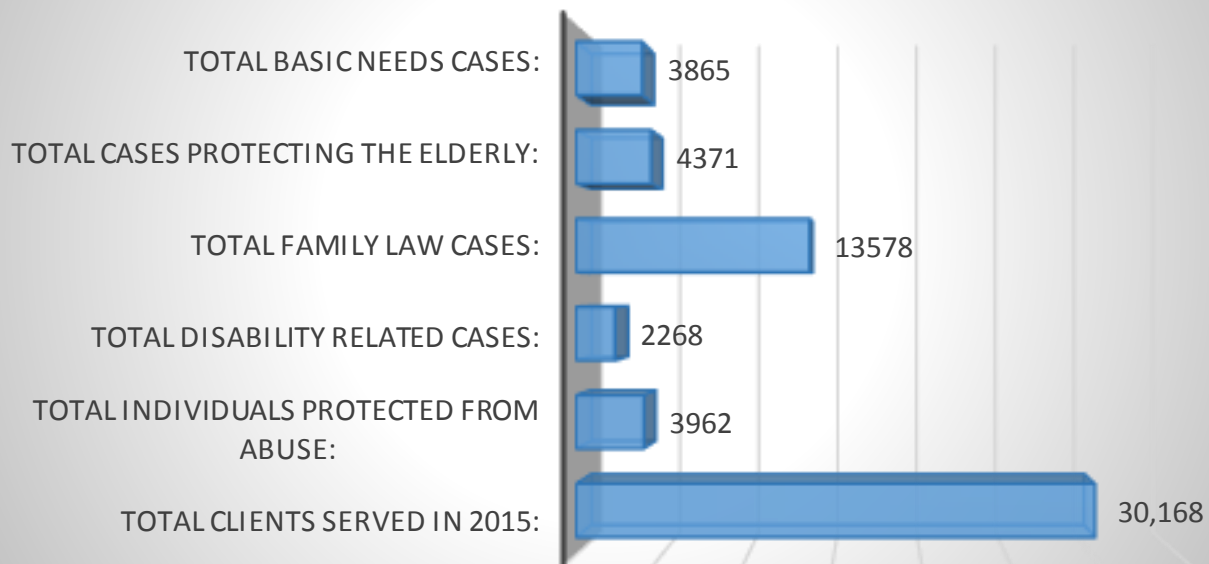

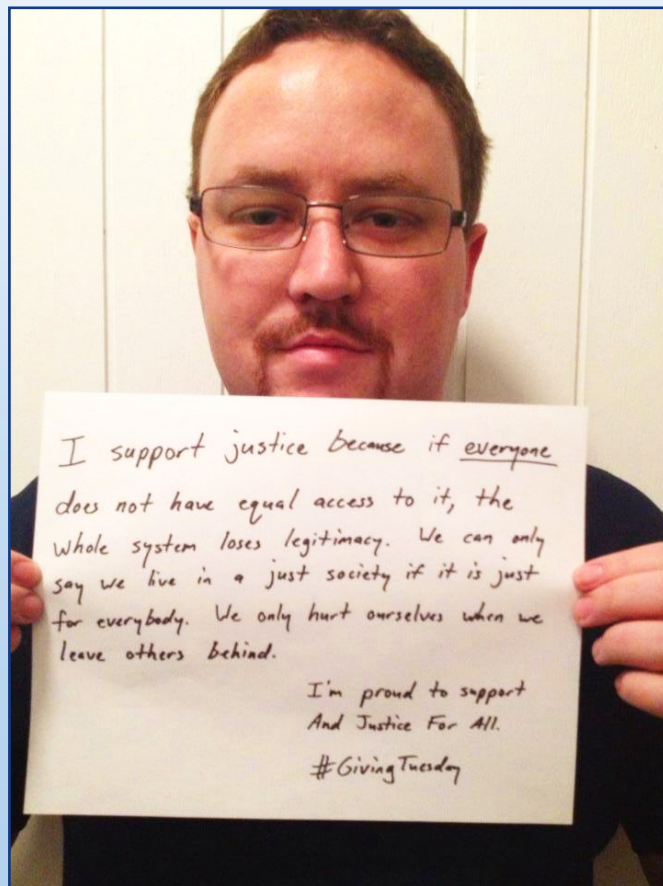
I've been engaged with AJFA since just after law school. I've always admired AJFA's mission and wanted to help however possible, especially once I was a practicing attorney.

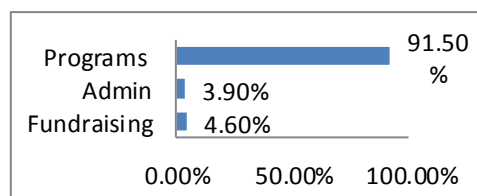

Protecting Children & Families – Securing the immediate and long term safety of child and adult victims of domestic violence by obtaining protective orders and civil stalking injunctions. **3,962 individuals helped last year.**

Stabilizing Families in Crisis – Providing assistance with domestic cases including divorce, custody, child support and visitation. **13,578 families helped last year.**

Disability Issues – Enforcing the laws that protect the rights of people with disabilities in education, abuse and neglect, accessibility, discrimination and access to service cases. **3,867 individuals helped last year.**

Meeting Basic Needs – Securing and protecting access to housing, food and utility assistance and financial assistance. **3,865 households helped last year.**

Protecting Vulnerable Seniors – Representing low-income seniors over 60 years of age with guardianship defense, medical benefits, housing, and consumer matters. **3,910 individuals helped last year**

Obtaining & Maintaining Income & Healthcare – Helping vulnerable individuals obtain and maintain primary sources of income and health care like Medicaid, Social Security and SSDI. **1,574 individuals helped last year.**

Promoting Independence – Assisting people with education and employment matters, including access to vocational rehabilitation services. **554 individuals helped last year.**

From those assisted above, an additional 20,030 individuals living in the households of our clients have benefitted from services .
