Subsidized Housing Maintained for Mother and Son & Homelessness Thwarted

Caroline, a disabled woman with a history of chronic homelessness, was receiving housing assistance and attending vocational school full time. Her son was kicked out of his father's home weeks before his eighteenth birthday and shortly before his anticipated high school graduation. He came to his mother for a place to stay. The Housing Authority demanded proof of custody either through court order or a statement from the father. However, there was no time to obtain a court order prior to the child's birthday, and the father refused to give Caroline anything verifying she had the child.

Caroline received eviction and termination notices for an “unauthorized occupant.” Fearing she and her son would end up on the streets, a situation she was working desperately to make a distant memory, Caroline contacted Utah Legal Services (ULS). ULS represented her in an administrative hearing with the Housing Authority arguing it was discriminatory to prevent a mother from caring for her child or to require additional documentation of their relationship and that the relevant housing program allowed children of recipients to reside in the unit. The applicable regulations ensured continued eligibility for assistance in such circumstances.

The hearing officer agreed and ruled that Caroline could continue to receive her housing assistance and her son could be added to her household. When the landlord refused to add the son to the lease, Caroline was able to obtain a moving packet and found a new and larger apartment for herself and her son. Both continue to attend school and live together, optimistic about their bright futures.

Disabled Woman Secures Independence for Herself and Others

Ramona fervently believes that independence is more than a word. While adjusting to the effects of Usher Syndrome, which has impaired her vision and hearing, Ramona values independence as “something worth fighting for.”

As her hearing and vision loss progressed, Ramona found it increasingly difficult to navigate the hospital where she frequently has appointments. First, the low volume of the hospital’s elevator signal left her standing in front of the elevators, unable to hear or see when she should enter. Next,

the elevator door sensor wasn’t working and the doors would close on her when she entered or exited, requiring serious effort to push them back open. She feared that her guide dog, Stormy, could be injured by the doors. This may force Stormy into retirement and Ramona could lose her companion, with a replacement dog costing \$57,000. Additionally, the hospital required Ramona to sign an electronic scanner, acknowledging that she understood documents that she couldn’t read. Finally, she missed out on after-care instructions.

Ramona explained the problems to the hospital and asked for changes, but medical personnel declined. They told her she should bring a companion to help her navigate the hospital and read personal medical information to her. Ramona didn’t want her friends to know the details of her medical life, or to require someone else to accompany her during visits. Frustrated, Ramona involved the Disability Law Center (DLC).

“They listened to my concerns and immediately took action, submitting a

request for accommodations,” says Ramona. Within a few months, the elevator volume was increased, the doors were fixed and Ramona was receiving medical information in an accessible format.

Now, Ramona has successfully contacted other compliance officers at six major businesses/facilities without getting the DLC involved. She’s leading change, INDEPENDENTLY.

Woman Protects Herself from Abuse and Rebuilds Life, Free of Violence

Samantha feared for her life. If she tried to leave her home, her husband would beat her mercilessly. Samantha desperately wanted to end the relationship, but her husband would go into a violent rage whenever she tried. She sought

help from the Legal Aid Society of Salt Lake, but was initially afraid to file a protective order. Samantha was married into a large plural marriage religion and knew her family would ostracize and disown her if she pressed

charges. She found the strength and courage to finally file for the protective order and is currently in the process of divorce and rebuilding her life—free of violence.

Adapting Services to Meet Current Needs

“AND JUSTICE FOR ALL” partner agencies are pleased to be tailoring services to meet the legal needs of various groups.

Utah Legal Services is a Pro Bono Innovations Fund grantee and is working on expanding services to clients in rural areas through video clinics, e-learning modules for better training of volunteers and a “Lawyer of the Day” help line. They’ve also started a project to help the chronically homeless and TANF (Temporary Assistance to Needy Families) recipients with expungement of criminal records that prevent these clients from moving into stable and long term housing and employment.

Utah Legal Services and the

Legal Aid Society of Salt Lake have a recent program that assists victims of sexual assault; the first time in our history we’ve had funding and a project devoted specifically to that clientele. Legal Aid Society is also piloting a program in conjunction with the Third District court and a cadre of pro bono attorneys to provide limited legal assistance to *pro se* litigants in family law cases.

The Disability Law Center is starting a project to address the unmet needs of violence survivors with disabilities, providing training, technical assistance and improving collaboration between domestic violence and disability service providers. The DLC has also opened a

Midvale City Justice Court clinic operating on the third Thursday of every month; started a project assisting vocational rehabilitation clients access employment services; and implemented a housing discrimination program a year ago that solidifies them as the only fair housing private enforcement agency in the state.

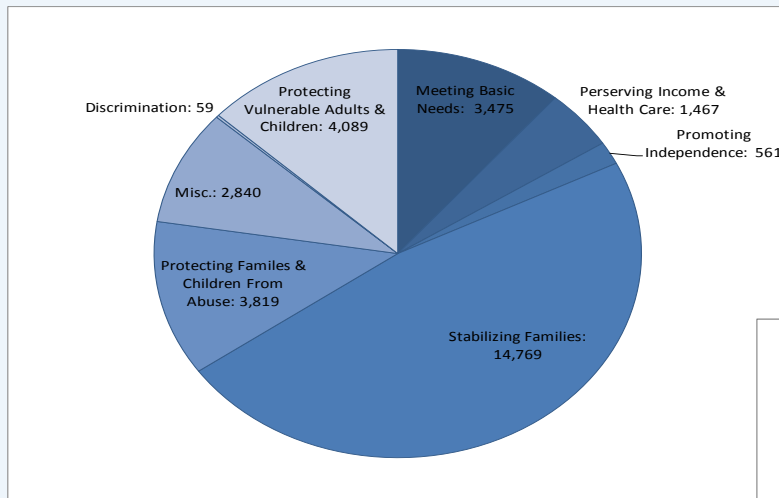

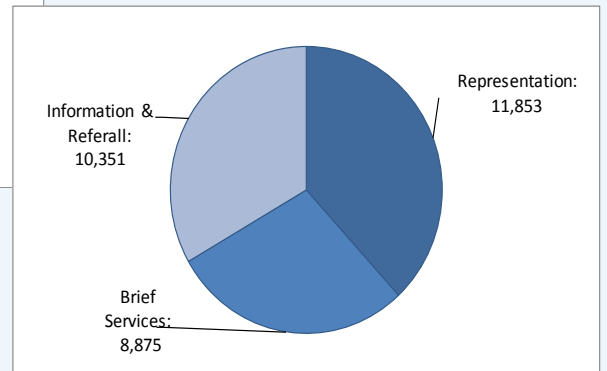
